Application for Rain Barrels

Rain barrels help promote water quality by reducing storm water runoff, which picks up pollutants on the ground and carries them to streams. Water collected in rain barrels can be stored and used to water plants and gardens.

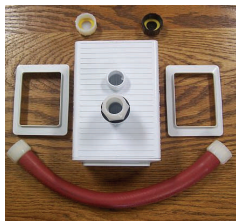


Rain barrels are made from recycled food grade barrels and have traveled many thousands of miles. They have been thoroughly cleaned inside and out, and have had several coats of a UV polish applied. They may have some scratches and scrapes, which should be considered as part of the “character” of the recycled barrels.

The barrels have a screw on top with one inch holes, screen mesh to keep out debris and mosquitoes, three top overflow male hose connections with caps, a nylon spigot, and a bottom drain plug. The overflow fittings allow excess water to be diverted to remote areas such as a garden or flower beds.

The nylon spigot is shipped inside the barrel and will need to be screwed into the pre-installed plastic fitting. The spigot should only be installed finger tight.

The nylon spigot can be interchanged with the bottom drain plug if desired.



The **“Aunt Molly’s” diverter** is a system that attaches to your downspout and will direct the rain water into your rain barrel. After the rain barrel is full, the diverter will automatically re-direct the rain water back into the downspout.



Flex elbows* may be used instead of diverters. The elbows direct rain water into the top of the barrels. The elbows are installed by removing a section of the downspout above the barrel; leaving the bottom section attached to the house. If the elbow is installed in this manner, you can insert the elbow into the bottom section of the downspout when the barrel is removed or filled with water.



Ready built 12” **rain barrel connectors**. The rain barrels will connect through the top overflow valves.
